Title Finish the story

Skill developing writing, reading, pronunciation.

Useful to learn... connectives (and, then, next, after, while, therefore, moreover, afterwards, meanwhile, sadly, happily, etc.)/ story telling.

Aim use connectives while telling/writing a story.

Individual / Pair / Group Individual, pairs and group.

Language level Advanced

Resources & Materials needed Video from youtube, a piece of paper.

Procedure

1. Play video until 1'43". (2')
 2. Discuss with the class what they have understood from the story. (5')
 3. Students write an end to the story in 300 words. (10')
 4. Students read their stories outloud in pairs. (5')
 5. Four volunteers read their stories outloud for the class. (10')
